I, on behalf of the Board of Directors, have the pleasure to submit the 28th Annual report together with the audited statement of accounts for the financial year ended 31st March,2011.

OPERATIONS :

The net profit of your company after tax for the year was Rs.1716.26 lacs against Rs.1763.35 lacs earned in the previous year, registering a decrease of 2.74%. However, the cash profit during the year stood at Rs.3,976.30 lacs against Rs.3,881.77 lacs earned during the previous year, achieving an increase of 2.43 percent.

DIVIDEND :

The profit of the Company has been reasonable; however with the objective to strengthen the reserve base to meet the growing need of funds, your Directors do not recommend any dividend.

DIRECTORS :

Shri Ram Swarup Rungta and Shri Sanjay Rungta retire by rotation at the forthcoming AGM and being eligible offer themselves for re-appointment. Moreover, during the period under reference Smt. Shanti Rungta, was appointed as an additional director by your Board. Her active participation in the management and unstinted support has helped your company in achieving its corporate goals to a great extent.

PUBLIC DEPOSITS :

The Company has not accepted any Deposit from the Public during the year under review.

CONSERVATION OF ENERGY, TECHNOLOGY ABSORPTION, FOREIGN EXCHANGE EARNINGS & OUTGO :

In compliance of the provision of Section 271(1) (C) of the Companies Act, 1956 read with the Companies (disclosure of particulars in the report of the Board of Directors) Rules, 1988, the Company has to report that :

- (a) Part A of Rule-2 of the said Rules has no application of the Company and

- (b) The Company had neither carried out any Research and Development work nor spent any amount on its as there is no scope of doing so because of its nature of business and :
